To Subscribers:

Re: Monthly Report for the month of April 2022

The Building Division report of building permit activity for April 2022 is enclosed for your perusal.

In April the Building Division issued 703 building permits valued at \$177.44 million.

For the month, the residential component was the strongest accounting for 79.81% of the month's total and is valued at \$141.61 million. Of the 501 permits in the residential category, 114 permits were issued for new single-family dwellings at a total value of \$46.00 million. Commercial activity accounts for 10.02% or \$17.78 million with 52 permits issued. Industrial activity accounts for 8.09% or \$14.35 million and the government and institutional activity accounts for 0.28% or \$0.49 million.

We trust these comments will aid you in the understanding of this report.
