Re: Monthly Report for the month of September 2022

The Building Division report of building activity for September 2022 is enclosed for your perusal.

In September the Building Division issued 571 building permits valued at \$143.76 million.

For the month, the residential component was the strongest accounting for 80.22% of the month's total and is valued at \$115.33 million. Of the 429 permits in the residential category, 141 permits were issued for new single-family dwellings at a total value of \$25.95 million. Commercial activity accounts for 13.37% or \$19.23 million with 43 permits issued. Industrial activity accounts for 5.61% or \$8.07 million and the government and institutional activity accounts for 0.26% or \$0.37 million.

We trust these comments will aid you in the understanding of this report.
