

THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HAMILTON-WENTWORTHBY-LAW NO. R85-012

BEING A BY-LAW TO INCREASE WATER RATES AND TO
 REPEAL SCHEDULES "A", "B", "C" AND "E" OF
 BY-LAW R84-026 AND TO MAKE SUBSTITUTIONS THEREFOR


WHEREAS Regional Council did approve Item 7 of Finance Committee Report 3-85;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HAMILTON-WENTWORTH
 ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. An increase of 4% in water rates for all non-metered water billings in the City of Hamilton and the City of Stoney Creek for 1985 .
2. For residential metered water services with a meter of 20MM or smaller an increase of 4% in metered water rates for bills issued on or after March 1, 1985 for water consumed on or after January 1, 1985.
3. For commercial, institutional, industrial and residential metered water services greater than 20MM, the following rate increase be applied for bills issued on or after March 1, 1985 for water consumed on or after January 1, 1985
 - (i) An increase of 4% on minimum rates;
 - (ii) An increase of \$0.0088 per cubic metre on the next 227 cubic metres for each quarter;
 - (iii) An increase of \$0.0092 per cubic metre on the next 2,454 cubic metres for each quarter;
 - (iv) An increase of \$0.0092 per cubic metre over 2,727 cubic metres for each quarter.
4. The rate payable for water supplied to tank trucks at the Region's coin-operated stations be increased to \$0.466 per cubic metre effective February 11, 1985 .
5. Metered water consumers having an annual consumption in 1984, in excess of 100,000 cubic metres, be billed on a monthly basis by August 1, 1985:
6. That the the water/sewer rate structure regarding minimum charges and step down rates be reviewed in 1985.
7. Schedules "A", "B", "C" and "E" to By-Law No. R84-026 are hereby repealed and the attached Schedules substituted therefor.

C) DISCOUNTS FOR PROMPT PAYMENT

All amounts for water at rates provided in this schedule are subject to a five percent (5%) discount if paid on or before the discount date shown on the bill, which date is to be at least ten days later than the billing date.

SCHEDULE "C"
MISCELLANEOUS RATES FOR WATER

(Referred to in Section 12(6), (7), (8) and (9))

1. Travelling Shows
The deposit required from travelling shows is Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), of which the sum of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) is the fee for connecting and disconnecting the water supply and a Five (\$5.00) Dollar/day usage charge for three days.
2. Tank Trucks
The rate for water supplied to tank trucks is \$0.466 per cubic metre or part thereof, and such trucks shall only be supplied at the following locations:
 - (i) Norfolk Street (Fire Station), Hamilton
 - (ii) Shavers Road, Ancaster
 - (iii) Dartnall Road, Hamilton
3. Street Hydrants
The rate payable by Area Municipalities for the use of street hydrants is One Hundred and Thirty Dollars (\$130.00) per annum for each street hydrant within the municipality.
4. Areas Outside the Regional Area
The rate for water supplied to municipalities for the owner or occupier of any lands outside the Regional Area is the applicable meter rate set forth in Schedule "B", plus fifty per cent (50%) surcharge or such other surcharge as may be specifically defined in the Agreement between the Regional Corporation and the municipality, owner or occupier of the lands outside the Regional area.
