Council Direction:

“In 1998, the former Hamilton City Council directed that the practice of the former Hamilton Parking Authority Board of exchanging parking privileges in off-street parking lots for parking advertising, season tickets, etc, to various events be continued provided that the tickets are made available first to Council members for charitable purposes and then directly to charities, and that staff report annually on the disposition of event tickets.”

Information:

To date, City Council has approved on-going “Parking for Services in Kind” arrangements for the Hamilton Bulldogs Hockey Club, the Hamilton Tiger-Cats, Opera Hamilton and Theatre Aquarius. Any future requests for financial support of community events and organizations would be directed to the Planning and Economic Development Committee in accordance with the current policy.
