



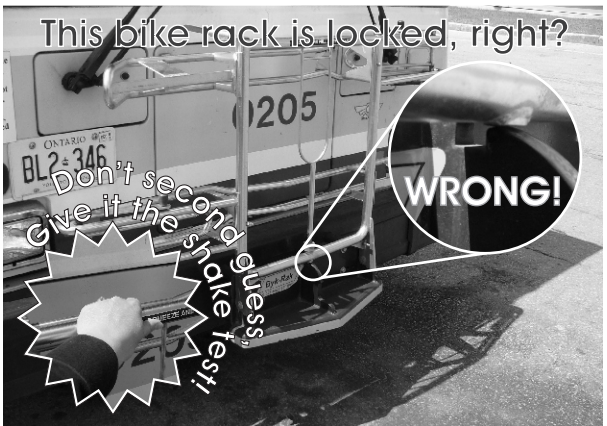
# Listen for the **CLICK!**

Just put your bike on the bike rack? Great! Thanks for doing your part to help the environment! We'd just like to remind you of some important safety concerns regarding the use of HSR bike racks:

It is the **responsibility** of the rider to load, secure, and unload their bike. The Operator is not required to help in this process. The HSR is not responsible for loss, damage, or theft. If you are unsure about the operation of the bike rack, ask the Operator.

## When unloading...

- Always inform the Operator in plenty of time that you will be unloading your bike.
- Always exit the bus from the front door, signal the Operator that you will be unloading, and approach the rack from the curb side.
- When unloading, if there are no other bikes on the rack, please fold it up and **lock** it in place. Be sure to listen for the **click**. This ensures it is safely locked in the upright position. **Before you leave, give the bike rack a tug to double check it is locked.**
- Always exit to the curb side.
