When waiting at your bus stop, ensure your smoke does not bother others. Please 'butt out' before the bus arrives. If possible, take your cigarette butt with you to cut down on litter. These small actions are appreciated by non-smokers and can help improve the attractiveness of public transit for everyone.

Remember, smoking is prohibited anywhere on HSR buses and in all HSR transit shelters.
