

Process to hire city's next police chief underway

Chief Eric Girt announced his retirement in December

Hamilton could see a new police chief hired by April after Chief Eric Girt announced his retirement last month.

Mayor Fred Eisenberger, chair of the Hamilton police services board, said the process is already underway. The board has hired the firm Odgers Berndtson to lead community consultations to assess what Hamiltonians want to see in their next chief.

They will be looking at both internal and external candidates. Eisenberger said the process will probably take until April.

"It's one of the most important jobs (of the board) and one we're looking forward to," he said, adding it's a process the whole board will participate in.

Eisenberger said he believes they need someone with strong

leadership, appropriate qualifications and strong communication skills, "especially when communicating with the public at large."

He is also hoping the top job attracts diverse candidates.

"It would be great to have the opportunity to look at female candidates and candidates from diverse communities," Eisenberger said.

Girt announced his retire-

ment at the Dec. 17 police board meeting. Over his 35-year career, Girt rose through the ranks at Hamilton police, including 14 years in senior command, as deputy chief and then chief since 2016. His five-year contract was up in May, however, Girt opted to leave early to give time for a smoother transition. He's officially gone in February, but is using vacation time in January.

Girt appointed the police service's two deputy chiefs to alternate month to month as acting chief for the interim. In January it is deputy chief Frank Bergen and in February it will be deputy chief Ryan Diodati.

Girt's retirement comes amid mounting public pressure on policing internationally and in Hamilton, including fallout after a violent clash involving homophobic disrupters at Pride in 2019 and the defund the police movement. In an interview with The Spectator when he announced his retirement, Girt said that criticism did not play a role in his decision to retire.

"If I had a choice, I'd prefer that he didn't leave," Eisenberger said, adding that he respects Girt's decision.

Girt has done "an outstanding job," he said, bringing a wealth of experience to the job.

But Eisenberger also acknowledged the pressures facing police in Hamilton and elsewhere, and the need to find the right fit for the new chief.

The police board is hosting

two virtual town hall events later this month to discuss policing issues that will include live polls and question and answers. Eisenberger said there will also be outreach to community leaders and broader surveys to help the board understand the needs for the next chief. The police board has not yet begun accepting applications, but a call out is expected as soon as the next couple of weeks.

The virtual town halls will take place Jan. 26 and 27 from 7:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. They will be livestreamed on the Hamilton police Facebook page. Residents will participate through a randomized call out to City of Hamilton land lines. Residents without a land line who wish to be included in the pool can register a phone number by 4 p.m. Jan. 25 at hpspublicmeeting.com. Results from the town halls will be posted on the police board website.

Province won't let public health talk about vaccine supply

4,900 residents in 27 care homes and those in 'high risk' retirement homes to be vaccinated by Jan. 18

Hamiltonians remain in the dark about the state of our vaccine supply thanks to a gag order issued by the province.

But we know long-term-care residents are getting vaccinated. And Moderna is on its way.

On Monday, Hamilton's medical officer of health confirmed the province had issued a directive to public health to stop sharing information about the city's COVID vaccine supply. It remains unclear why the prov-

ince issued the directive or if other public health units have been told the same.

The province did not respond to questions about why they've silenced public health. One expert thinks it might be an effort to pre-emptively stave off vaccine rollout criticism.

But there's some good news: more than 8,000 people have been vaccinated in Hamilton as of Wednesday morning. That includes about 750 residents of long-term care.

Public health confirmed

Wednesday residents at Idlewyld Manor, St. Peter's Residence, Hamilton Continuing Care, Macassa Lodge and Shalom Village have all been vaccinated. Wentworth Heights residents were being vaccinated Wednesday and Arbour Creek and Grace Villa are scheduled for Thursday.

A total of 4,900 long-term-care residents in 27 homes and those in 10 "high risk" retirement homes are expected to be vaccinated via a mobile clinic by Jan. 18.

Hamilton's fixed-site vaccination clinic is currently vaccinating around 1,000 people a day, including long-term-care staff

and front-line hospital workers.

The last update Hamilton received about vaccine supply came last week: public health confirmed we had 6,000 of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine. All doses came as part of one shipment that arrived the week of Dec. 21.

On Monday, Dr. Elizabeth Richardson, Hamilton's medical officer of health, said: "I can tell you we continue to receive volumes as we move forward."

As for the province's silencing directive, Dr. Zain Chagla, an infectious diseases physician at St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton, said it might be an attempt to quell criticism if vaccine roll-

out didn't go as planned.

"(They're) moving on the fly," said Chagla of the province's efforts to vaccinate Ontarians.

The province is juggling supply with demand, he said, and in some cases, it might have to take vaccines destined for arms in one region and send them to another.

Indeed, such a scenario unfolded Wednesday when the Niagara Health hospital organization wrote an open letter to the province, decriing the "inexplicable diversion" of promised Moderna vaccines.
