

Hamilton could see a new po-lice chief hired by April after Chief Eric Girt announced his retirement last month. Mayor Fred Eisenberger, chair of the Hamilton police

services board, said the process services board, said the process is already underway. The board has hired the firm Odgers Berndtson to lead community consultations to assess what Hamiltonians want to see in their next chief. They will be looking at both

internal and external candidates. Eisenberger said the pro-cess will probably take until April.
"It's one of the most impor-

tts one of the most impor-tant jobs (of the board) and one we're looking forward to," he said, adding it's a process the whole board will participate in. Eisenberger said he believes they need someone with strong
