**CITY OF HAMILTON**

**BY-LAW NO. 04- 131**

**To Amend By-law No. 01-215  
Being a By-law To Regulate Traffic**

**WHEREAS** Section 210(123) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, as amended, confers upon the councils of all municipalities the power to enact by-laws for regulating traffic on highways subject to the Highway Traffic Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 314(7) of the Municipal Act confers upon councils of all municipalities the power to enact by-laws to provide for placing, regulating and maintaining upon the public highways traffic signs for the purpose of guiding and directing traffic;

**AND WHEREAS** on the 18th day of September, 2001, the Council of the City of Hamilton enacted By-law No. 01-215 to regulate traffic;

**AND WHEREAS** it is necessary to amend By-law No. 01-215;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Schedule 5 (Stop Signs) of By-law No. 01-215, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding to Section "D" thereof the following item, namely:

"Fulmar Way	Northbound	Provident Way
Fulmar Way	Southbound	Thames Way
Hampton Brook Way	Northbound	Thames Way
Hollybank Way	Northbound	Provident Way
Hollybank Way	Southbound	Rosebury Way
Malwood Drive	Southbound	Provident Way
Provident Way	Eastbound and Westbound	Solsbury Crescent
Rosebury Way	Eastbound and Westbound	Fulmar Way

Solsbury Way	Eastbound	Fulmar Way
Stoneglen Way	Westbound	Penfold Court”


and by adding to Section "E" thereof the following items, namely:

“Burfield	Westbound	Brentwood
Burfield	Eastbound	Kingslea
Endfield	Westbound	Brentwood
Endfield	Eastbound	Kingslea
Grandfield	Westbound	Brentwood
Grandfield	Eastbound	Kingslea”

2. Subject to the amendments made in this By-law, in all other respects, By-law No. 01-215, including all Schedules thereto, as amended, is hereby confirmed unchanged.
3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its passing and enactment.
