## BY-LAW NO. 04-261

## BEING A BY-LAW TO PERMANENTLY CLOSE AND SELL PART OF THE UNOPENED ROAD ALLOWANCE BETWEEN 711 & 723 RIDGE ROAD, STONEY CREEK, BEING PART OF THE ORIGINAL ROAD ALLOWANCE BETWEEN LOTS 14 & 15, CONCESSION 3 (UNOPENED) IN THE GEOGRAPHIC TOWNSHIP OF SALTFLEET, LYING BETWEEN THE TORONTO, HAMILTON & BUFFALO RAILWAY LANDS AND RIDGE ROAD, STONEY CREEK, DESIGNATED AS PARTS 1 & 2 ON PLAN 62R-16479, CITY OF STONEY CREEK, NOW CITY OF HAMILTON

**WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Hamilton is empowered under Section 34 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended, to permanently close any highway or part of a highway;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Hamilton on September 15, 2004, in adopting Item 30 of the Planning & Economic Development Committee authorized the City to permanently close and sell part of the unopened road allowance between 711 & 723 Ridge Road, Stoney Creek, designated as Parts 1 & 2 on Plan 62R-16479;

**AND WHEREAS** the road is a highway under the jurisdiction of the City of Hamilton;

**AND WHEREAS** notice of the City's intention to pass this By-law has been published pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. That the part of the unopened road allowance, set out as:

PIN 17359-0235(LT)

Part of the Original Road Allowance between Lots 14 and 15, Concession 3 (Unopened), in the geographic Township of Saltfleet, lying between the

Toronto, Hamilton & Buffalo Railway lands and Ridge Road, designated as Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 62R-16479, City of Stoney Creek, now City of Hamilton,

is hereby permanently closed.

- 2. That the soil and freehold of Parts 1 and 2 on Plan 62R-16479 hereby permanently closed, be sold to Edna Chrystian for the sum of Nineteen Thousand and Eight Hundred Dollars (\$19,800.00).
- 3. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its registration in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Wentworth (No. 62).
