BY-LAW NO. 05-283

To Amend By-law No. 01-215 Being a By-law To Regulate Traffic

WHEREAS Section 11(1)1 of the <u>Municipal Act</u>, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, confers upon the councils of all municipalities the power to enact by-laws for regulating parking and traffic on highways subject to the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u>;

AND WHEREAS on the 18th day of September, 2001, the Council of the City of Hamilton enacted By-law No. 01-215 to regulate traffic;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to amend By-law No. 01-215.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Schedule 5 (Stop Signs) of By-law No. 01-215, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding to Section "C" thereof the following items, namely:

"Alderson Rd. Eastbound Alger Crt."

and by adding to Section "E" thereof the following item, namely;

"Duke St. Westbound Park St Kathleen Ct. Westbound East 45th St. Rideau Cr. Eastbound Moxley Dr."

and by adding to Section "A" thereof the following item, namely;

"Book Rd. W. Eastbound and Westbound Alberton Rd."

and by deleting from Section " Athereof the following item, namely;

"Highland Park Dr. Westbound Bridlewood Dr."

2. Subject to the amendments made in this By-law, in all other respects, By-law No. 01-215, including all Schedules thereto, as amended, is hereby confirmed unchanged.

3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its passing and enactment.
