BY-LAW NO. 06- 148

To Amend By-law No. 01-215 Being a By-law To Regulate Traffic

WHEREAS Section 11(1)1 of the <u>Municipal Act</u>, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, confers upon the councils of all municipalities the power to enact by-laws for regulating parking and traffic on highways subject to the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u>;

AND WHEREAS on the 18th day of September, 2001, the Council of the City of Hamilton enacted By-law No. 01-215 to regulate traffic;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to amend By-law No. 01-215.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Schedule 5 (Stop Signs) of By-law No. 01-215, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding to Section "C" thereof the following item, namely:

"Inksetter Rd. Southbound Governors Rd."

and by adding to Section "E" thereof the following item, namely:

"Beach Rd. Westbound Dofasco Blvd. Hillyard St. Northbound Land St."

and by adding to Section "F" thereof the following item, namely:

"Sasha Ct. Southbound Hemlock Ave. Paramount Dr. Northbound and Southbound Mistywood Dr."

2. Subject to the amendments made in this By-law, in all other respects, By-law No. 01-215, including all Schedules thereto, as amended, is hereby confirmed unchanged.

3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its passing and enactment.
