BY-LAW NO. 06-170

BEING A BY-LAW TO PERMANENTLY CLOSE AND SELL PART OF OLD MUD STREET ROAD ALLOWANCE (NOT TRAVELLED), being PART OF THE ROAD ALLOWANCE between CONCESSIONS 6 AND 7, (GEOGRAPHIC TOWNSHIP OF SALTFLEET), DESIGNATED AS PART 1 ON PLAN 62R-17499, CITY OF HAMILTON

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is empowered under Section 34 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended, to permanently close any highway or part of a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton on January 25, 2006, in adopting Item 6 of the Public Works, Infrastructure and Environment Committee Report 06-001, authorized the City to permanently close and sell part of Old Mud Street Road Allowance (Not travelled), being part of the Road Allowance between Concessions 6 and 7, (Geographic Township of Saltfleet), designated as Part 1, Plan 62R-17499, City of Hamilton.

AND WHEREAS the road is a highway under the jurisdiction of the City of Hamilton;

AND WHEREAS notice of the City's intention to pass this By-law has been published pursuant to the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. That the part of the unopened road allowance, set out as:

Old Mud Street Road Allowance (Not travelled), being part of the Road Allowance between Concessions 6 and 7, in the Geographic Township of Saltfleet, now in the City of Hamilton, designated as Part 1, Plan 62R-17499

is hereby permanently closed.

- 2. That the soil and freehold of Part 1 on Plan 62R-17499, hereby permanently closed, be sold to 1478551 Ontario Inc. for the sum of Thirty-Two Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$32,800.00).
- 3. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its registration in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Wentworth (No. 62).
