## CITY OF HAMILTON

**BY-LAW NO. 06-281** 

To Amend City of Hamilton By-law No. 01-084
Being a By-law to Appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers

**WHEREAS** Section 15(1) of the <u>Police Services Act</u> R.S.O. 1990, c.P.15, as amended, authorizes the council of any municipality to appoint one or more Municipal Law Enforcement Officers, who shall be peace officers for the purposes of enforcing the by-laws of the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 11(1) of the <u>Municipal Act, 2001</u> S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, authorizes the council of any single tier municipality to pass by-laws respecting matters within its spheres of jurisdiction;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Hamilton, on the 15th day of May, 2001, did pass and enact By-law No. 01-084, being a by-law to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the City of Hamilton;

**AND WHEREAS** it is necessary to amend By-law No. 01-084.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows.

1. By-law No. 01-084, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding to Schedule "A" thereof the following names:

"Susan M. McGrath Bradley J. Potts"

and by deleting from Schedule "A" thereof the following name:

"Michael Bain"
