Amendment No. 208 to the Official Plan for the former City of Hamilton

The following text together with Schedule "A", City of Hamilton - Land Use Concept, attached hereto, constitute Official Plan Amendment No. 208.

Purpose:

The purpose of this Amendment is to redesignate the subject lands from "Industrial" to "Central Policy Area" to permit the expansion of institutional uses.

Location:

The lands affected by this Amendment are described as the rear portion of 237 Barton Street East in the former City of Hamilton (Hamilton General Hospital site).

Basis:

The amendment can be supported on the following basis:

- The amendment is consistent with the Provincial Policy Statement respecting growth in settlement areas (Policy 1.1.3.1) and which promote a range of uses including Institutional (Policy 1.1.1(b)).
- The proposal conforms to and implements the "Urban Area" policies of the Hamilton-Wentworth Official Plan;
- The proposal implements the City of Hamilton Official Plan policies which identify the Central Policy Area as a focus for Major Institutional uses and directs new institutional uses on lands adjacent to existing institutional uses.
- The proposed uses are compatible with the existing uses within the immediate area.

Actual Changes:

1. Schedule "A" – Land Use Concept is revised by redesignating the subject land from "Industrial" to "Central Policy Area" as shown on Schedule "A" attached to this Amendment.

Implementation:

An implementing Zoning By-Law Amendment and site plan will give effect to the intended use on the subject lands.
