## CITY OF HAMILTON BY-LAW NO. 06-312 To Amend By-law No. 01-215 Being a By-law To Regulate Traffic

**WHEREAS** Section 11(1)1 of the <u>Municipal Act</u>, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, confers upon the councils of all municipalities the power to enact by-laws for regulating parking and traffic on highways subject to the <u>Highway Traffic Act</u>;

**AND WHEREAS** on the 18th day of September, 2001, the Council of the City of Hamilton enacted By-law No. 01-215 to regulate traffic;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to amend By-law No. 01-215.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Schedule 5 (Stop Signs) of By-law No. 01-215, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding to Section "E" thereof the following items, namely:

"Allandale St.	Northbound	Hope St.
Blackthorne Ave.	Southbound	Millwood Pl.
Huntington Ave.	Westbound	Brentwood Dr.
Huntington Ave.	Eastbound	Kingslea Dr.
Uplands Ave.	Northbound	Franklin Ave.
Hess St.	Northbound	Market St."

and by adding to Section "D" thereof the following item, namely:

"Guyatt Rd.

Eastbound & Westbound

Hendershot Rd."

- 2. Subject to the amendments made in this By-law, in all other respects, By-law No. 01-215, including all Schedules thereto, as amended, is hereby confirmed unchanged.
- 3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its passing and enactment.
