## **CITY OF HAMILTON**

### **BY-LAW NO. 06-343**

#### **To Implement the 2007 Fees and Charges for Laboratory Services**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to section 391 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of the municipality and for the use of the municipality's property, including property under its control;

**AND WHEREAS** on the 13th day of December, 2006, the Council of the City of Hamilton did approve of Item X of Committee of the Whole Report 06-023 and did authorize the 2007 water and wastewater fees and charges, including the fees and charges for laboratory services set out herein;


**AND WHEREAS** notice of the 2007 fees and charges for laboratory services set out herein has been given in a form and in the manner and at the times that the Council considers adequate.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. That the fees and charges in Schedule "A" to this By-law be imposed for laboratory services provided by the City of Hamilton as specified therein.
2. That By-law No. 05-375, being a by-law to implement the 2006 fees and charges for laboratory services, is hereby repealed.

3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect as of the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2007.
