BY-LAW NO. 08-082

To Amend By-law No. 01-218, as amended, Being a By-law To Regulate On-Street Parking

WHEREAS Section 11(1)1 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, as amended, confers upon the councils of all municipalities the power to enact by-laws for regulating parking and traffic on highways subject to the Highway Traffic Act;

AND WHEREAS on the 18th day of September, 2001, the Council of the City of Hamilton enacted By-law No. 01-218 to regulate on-street parking;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to amend By-law No. 01-218, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

Schedule 6 (Time Limit Parking) of By-law No. 01-218, as amended, is hereby 1. further amended by adding to Section "E" thereof the following item, namely:

"Dalcar South Upper Paradise to 1 hr Anvtime Anyday" 40m easterly

2. Schedule 12 (Permit Parking Zones) of By-law No. 01-218, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding to Section "E" thereof the following items, namely:

"Campbell	North	from 13.8m east of Rosslyn to 5.5m easterly	Anytime
Francis	North	from 58.1m west of Cheever to 6.7m westerly	Anytime
Francis	South	from 45.5m west of Cheever to 5.9m westerly	Anytime
Oak	West	from 81.7m south of Barton to 6m southerly	Anytime"

- 3. Subject to the amendments made in this By-law, in all other respects, By-law No. 01-218, including all Schedules thereto, as amended, is hereby confirmed unchanged.
- 4. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its passing and enactment.
