BY-LAW NO. 10-011

Respecting:

Removal of Part Lot Control Blocks 90 – 93, Registered Plan No. 62M-1117, "Northampton Estates" and Block 183, Registered Plan No. 62M-992, "Southampton Estates – Phase 1"

WHEREAS the sub-section 50(5) of the <u>*Planning Act*</u>, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

"(7) **Designation of lands not subject to part lot control.** -- Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, for the purpose of creating lots for single detached dwellings, shown as Parts 1 and 2, Parts 3, 4 and 5, and Parts 6 and 7, inclusive, and a portion of land for road widening purposes, shown as Part 8, on deposited Reference Plan 62R-18633, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Blocks 90 – 93, Registered Plan No. 62M-1117, in the City of Hamilton, and Block 183, Registered Plan No. 62-992, in the City of Hamilton.

- 2. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
- 3. This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 27th day of January, 2012.
