## CITY OF HAMILTON **BY-LAW NO. 10-227**

Respecting:

Removal of Part Lot Control Lot 7 and Part of Lot 6, Registered Plan No. 62M-227 Hamilton Mountain Industrial Park (1)

WHEREAS the sub-section 50(5) of the Planning Act, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision:

**AND WHEREAS** sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

Designation of lands not subject to part lot control. -- Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, for the purpose of creating one part to be merged with the adjacent lands, 1275 Rymal Road East, shown as Part 2, on deposited Reference Plan 62R-18812, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Lot 7 and Part of Lot 6, Registered Plan No. 62M-227, in the City of Hamilton

- 2. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
- This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of 3. September, 2012.
