**CITY OF HAMILTON
BY-LAW NO. 05-028
TO ESTABLISH CITY LAND
DESIGNATED AS PART 2 ON PLAN 62R-6388 AS
LIBRARY LANE**

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is empowered under Section 31(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25 and amendments thereto, to establish a highway.

AND WHEREAS on the 21st day of January, 1983, the former Township of Glanbrook passed and enacted By-law No. 260-83 and assumed certain lands as a roadway named Library Lane.

AND WHEREAS as a result of By-law No. 260-83 of the former Township of Glanbrook, and the expenditure of public funds on the said Library Lane, the City of Hamilton considers the said Library Lane to have been a public highway since the passing and enactment of said By-law No. 260-83.

AND WHEREAS after January 1, 2003, the Municipal Act, 2001 requires municipalities to pass a by-law in order to establish a highway.

AND WHEREAS while the City of Hamilton considers Library Lane to already be a public highway, for the purposes of clarification only, the Council of the City of Hamilton desires to confirm the intention of the said By-law No. 260-83 and the establishment and opening of the land described in this By-law as the highway known as Library Lane;

AND WHEREAS the said land is owned by the City of Hamilton.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. That the following land is hereby established and laid out as a public highway to form Library Lane.

Part of Lot 5, Block 3, Concession 3, in the Geographic Township of Binbrook, now in the City of Hamilton. Designated as Part 2 on Plan 62R-6388.



2. That the General Manager of Public Works or his duly authorized agent is hereby authorized to open the said land as a public highway.


3. That this by-law comes into force and takes effect on the date of its registration in the Land Registry Office (No. 62).
