BY-LAW No. 12-187

Respecting:

Removal of Part Lot Control Lots 42-43, 56, 58, 60, 62, 76, 78, 82, and 86 of Plan No. 62M-1157 "Waterdown Bay"

WHEREAS the sub-section 50(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

"(7) **Designation of lands not subject to part lot control.** -- Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, for the purpose of creating ten (10) maintenance easements for single detached dwelling lots, shown as Parts 1-2, 14-17, and 30-33 inclusive, on deposited Reference Plan 62R-19310, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Lots 42-43, 56, 58, 60, 62, 76, 78, 82, and 86 of Registered Plan No. 62M-1157, in the City of Hamilton.

- 2. This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.
- 3. This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 16th day of August, 2014.
