BY-LAW NO. 13-071

Respecting

Removal of Part Lot Control Lots 102 – 115, 118 – 130, Registered Plan No. 62M-1186

WHEREAS the sub-section 50(5) of the Planning Act, (R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

Designation of lands not subject to part lot control. -- Despite subsection (5), the council of "(7) a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

Sub-section 5 of Section 50 of the Planning Act, for the purpose of creating maintenance 1. easements, shown as Parts 1 - 41, inclusive, on deposited Reference Plan 62R-19509, shall not apply to the portion of the registered plan of subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Lots 102 – 115 and 118 – 130, Registered Plan No. 62M-1186, in the City of Hamilton

- This by-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force 2. and effect on the date of such registration.
- This by-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 27th day of March, 2015. 3.
