AND WHEREAS the road is a highway under the jurisdiction of the City of Hamilton:

AND WHEREAS notice of the City's intention to pass this By-law has been published pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

That the portion of Public Assumed Alleyway, being Part of the Alleyway 1. on Plan 1431, George Hamilton Survey, between John Street and Catherine Street and North of Main Street, Save and Except Part 1 on Plan 62R-19030. City of Hamilton, being All of PIN 17167-0235(LT), is hereby permanently closed.

- 2. That the soil and freehold of the portion of Public Assumed Alleyway, hereby permanently closed, be sold to Royal Connaught Inc., for the sum of Eighty Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars (\$80,500.00).
- 3. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of its registration in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Wentworth (No. 62).
