BY-LAW NO. 15-263

Respecting Removal of Part Lot Control Blocks 20 and 21, Registered Plan of Subdivision No. 62M-1212, "Legacy", for lands municipally known as 2, 3, 6, 7, 10, 11, 14, 18, 23, 27, 30, 31, 35, 38, 39, 43, 47, 51, 52, 56, 60, 64 and 68 Legacy Lane

WHEREAS the sub-section 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

"Designation of lands not subject to part lot control. -- Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Subsection 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, for the purpose of creating twenty-three (23) lots for single detached dwellings (Parts 1 to 69, both inclusive), utility and service easements (Parts 1 to 19, both inclusive, Parts 43 to 67, both inclusive, and Part 71), and a Common Element Condominium Corporation (Part 70) as shown on Deposited Reference Plan 62R-20194, shall not apply to the portion of the Registered Plan of Subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Blocks 20 and 21, Registered Plan of Subdivision 62M-1212, in the City of Hamilton.

2. This By-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.

Respecting Removal of Part Lot Control Blocks 20 and 21, Registered Plan of Subdivision No. 62M-1212, "Legacy", for lands municipally known as 2, 3, 6, 7, 10, 11, 14, 18, 23, 27, 30, 31, 35, 38, 39, 43, 47, 51, 52, 56, 60, 64 and 68 Legacy Lane

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3. This By-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 11th day of November, 2017.
