**CITY OF HAMILTON**

**BY-LAW NO. 17-253**

**Respecting Removal of Part Lot Control  
Part of Block of 112, Registered Plan of Subdivision No. 62M-1050,  
municipally known as 1890 Rymal Road East, Glanbrook**

**WHEREAS** the sub-section 50(5) of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, establishes part-lot control on land within registered plans of subdivision;

**AND WHEREAS** sub-section 50(7) of the *Planning Act*, provides as follows:

**“Designation of lands not subject to part lot control.** -- Despite subsection (5), the council of a local municipality may by by-law provide that subsection (5) does not apply to land that is within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts of them as are designated in the by-law.”

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the City of Hamilton is desirous of enacting such a by-law with respect to the lands hereinafter described;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. That Subsection 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, for the purpose of creating one hundred and ninety-four (194) lots for freehold townhouses (Parts 1 to 194 inclusive and Parts 196 to 211 inclusive), access and maintenance easements (Parts 196 to 211 inclusive) and Part 195, being land comprised of the Common Elements Condominium Corporation for a private roadway, landscaped area and visitor parking, as shown on Deposited Reference Plan 62R-20714, shall not apply to the portion of the Registered Plan of Subdivision that is designated as follows, namely:

Part of Block 112, Registered Plan of Subdivision 62M-1050, in the City of Hamilton.

2. This By-law shall be registered on title to the said designated land and shall come into force and effect on the date of such registration.

3. This By-law shall expire and cease to be of any force or effect on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of November, 2019.
