

The property is affiliated with the Anglican Church. The property has direct associations with potentially significant person (George Leith). The property yields, or has the potential to yield, information that contributes to an understanding of a commun

#### **Preliminary Contextual Value:**

The property is historically, functionally, physically and visully linked to its surroundings. The property is located within the historic settlement area of Woodburn and is located at the end of Ridge Street across from the Edmunds House, another early stone building in Woodburn, and is also adjacent to Christ Church Woodburn Cemetery. The property may be considered to be a local landmark.
