



When can signs be placed and when must signs be removed?

- Signs can be placed as of September 26, 2022 at 12:01am
- Signs must be removed by October 27, 2022 at 11:59pm



How big can Election signs be?

- Residential cannot be larger than 1.5 square metres
- Other can be larger, but must follow Part 5 of the Sign By-Law

Hamilton What is allowed on City property?

- Holding a hand-held sign
- Displaying a **poster** (designated areas)
- Signs on a vehicle while in authorized use on City property
- Displayed in commercial space where authorized



There is **no limit** to the number of election signs that can be placed on a property.
