City Council approved report PW19015, Hamilton Strategic Road Safety Program and Vision Zero Action Plan in February 2019. As part of this approval, it directed staff to continue with the installation of Pedestrian Crossovers (PXO) throughout the City of Hamilton.

The City of Hamilton began installing PXO's in 2016, and to date have completed 76.

The PXO program and pedestrian safety is one of the primary roadway safety objectives for the Hamilton Strategic Road Safety Program and the Vision Zero Action Plan. PXO's provide pedestrians the right-of-way over motor vehicles at designated locations using traffic signs and pavement markings.

Based on an assessment of requests, below are the 14 locations that have been identified and are scheduled for construction in 2019. These locations are subject to contract costing received for the installation.

PXO installations are approved and funded through the 2019 Capital Budget.
