Live on the mountain? Mohawk College will be hosting a satellite Bike Day event at the Fennell campus near the library (<u>see map</u>) on June 1 from 8 a.m. to 10 a.m. Or join one of Cycle Hamilton's rides down to City Hall.

This event aims to bring together and grow the cycling culture in Hamilton. This event encourages those who have never cycled to work or school, try cycling as a commuting. Approximately 15% to 20% of participants in the Bike Day event are trying cycling as a commute-mode for the first time.
