BY-LAW NO. 22-126

To Appoint a Drainage Superintendent

WHEREAS Section 93 of the *Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990* authorizes the council of a local municipality to appoint a Drainage Superintendent and provide for remuneration for services performed by the Drainage Superintendent in carrying out the provisions of this Act as set out therein;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 23 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, authorizes all municipalities to appoint such officers and servants as may be necessary for carrying into effect the provisions of any Act of the Legislature and to fix their remuneration and prescribe their duties.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. Donald Young is appointed as Drainage Superintendent for the City of Hamilton;
2. The Drainage Superintendent shall carry out the duties imposed on them pursuant to the *Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990* and shall submit such reports and carry out such other duties as may be required of them by Council from time to time;
3. City of Hamilton By-Law No. 16-160 is repealed; and
4. This By-law comes into force on the day it is passed.
