What are other examples of exploratory, studio based projects that the City is interested in?

The City Enrichment Fund accepts proposals from any artistic discipline. We recognize that an artist's practice may fluctuate as part of their creative process and as a result it may be difficult to set precise goals at the time of their application.

If you have an exploratory-based studio practice, I encourage you to describe how you work, how you make creative choices, and how or in what form has your past work has materialized.

Please do not hesitate to reach out to me to discuss your project specifically so I may advise on language to help you draft exploratory-based outcome descriptions.

If the maximum budget request is no longer 30%, what percentage of the budget has to come from other sources?

The City Enrichment Fund will not fund 100% of the project's budget and applicants must demonstrate diverse revenue streams. The City has not put a cap on the maximum percentage, applicants are encouraged to review their budgets and determine a reasonable request from the City for their project. The jury will assess applications and determine project viability based in part on the budget breakdown. Please keep in mind that Established artists may request up to \$10,000, and Emerging artists may request up to \$5000 as maximum requests from CEF.

Can I apply for an individual artist project and a separate collective project?

Yes, Artists may apply as part of a collective and as an independent artist within the same funding year for distinct projects. Artists or collectives may only receive Creation & Presentation funding once every two years.
