#### NO PERSON SHALL OCCUPY A BUILDING UNLESS AN OCCUPANCY PERMIT HAS BEEN ISSUED Substantially complete in accordance with Ontario Building Code – Division C – Subsection 1.3.3.

- 1. All Ontario Building Code (OBC) requirements must be completed prior to submitting this form. If the occupancy inspection request is premature, an additional fee will apply for subsequent inspections as authorized by Building By-law 15-058.
- 2. Submit this form to <u>building@hamilton.ca</u>. Allow a minimum of three (3) business days for confirmation.
- 3. Upon confirmation, contact 905-546-2424 ext. 7777 / <u>building@hamilton.ca</u> to arrange occupancy inspection.
- Following the occupancy inspection, a minimum of two (2) business days are required to process and 4. issue an Occupancy Permit. The completed Occupancy Permit will be sent via email.
