The purpose of this Communication Update is to provide members of Council with information on upcoming construction activities related to the Summer's Lane Parking Garage. As notified through a Communications Update in April 2024, the Parking Structure below Summer's Lane is undergoing structural repairs given its age and declining condition. The next phase of repairs is scheduled to begin in early January 2025 and will focus on repairs to columns near the P3 Level Exit Tunnel. This work is expected to last approximately nine weeks.

Notices informing the approximately 470 permit holders of the upcoming work were sent by e-mail on January 2, 2025 outlining the work and timelines. In addition, staff have been in regular contact with the major users and neighbours of the Summer's Lane Parking Garage including the Art Gallery of Hamilton, Hamilton Convention Centre, First Ontario Concert Hall, and the Ellen Fairclough Building.

The structural repairs that are being carried out as part of the Summer's Lane Project are comprehensive and represent a major multi-year project. Work is being planned to occur in phases over the next several years to address structural conditions, waterproofing, accessibility, plumbing and drainage, and stairwells. When complete, these repairs will ensure that the garage can continue to meet the needs of its' users for years to come while contributing to a successful Downtown.

Staff will provide further updates to Council as work progresses.
