BY-LAW NO. 25-106

To Declare the Office of Councillor, Ward 8, to be Vacant

WHEREAS Councillor Danko is the elected Member of Hamilton City of Council representing Ward 8;

WHEREAS notice of Councillor Danko's election to serve in the House of Commons of Canada, representing Hamilton West-Ancaster-Dundas, was published in the Canada Gazette, Part 1, Volume 159, Number 7: Extra on May 9, 2025;

WHEREAS section 258 (1) 3. Of the Municipal Act, 2001 states that a member of the House of Commons of Canada is not eligible as to hold office as a member of a council;

WHEREAS section 259(1) states that the office of a member of council of a municipality becomes vacant if the member becomes ineligible to hold office under section 258;

WHEREAS section 262(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001 states that if the office of a member of a council becomes vacant under section 259, the council shall at its next meeting declare the office to be vacant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. The office of Councillor, Ward 8, be declared vacant.
