This Communication Update is to inform the Mayor and Members of Council that the annual general maintenance and asphalt repairs on the Lincoln M. Alexander Parkway scheduled for this coming weekend (May 23 – 26, 2025) will be postponed to next weekend (May 30 – June 2, 2025).

The postponement is due to forecasted weekend weather conditions to prioritize safety. Additionally, the Ministry of Transportation (MTO) will be closing two lanes of the Queen Elizabeth Way (QEW) Niagara-bound at the Burlington Skyway during the same time, May 23 to May 26, for maintenance work. Rescheduling the Lincoln M. Alexander repairs will help reduce traffic disruptions and minimize the impact on motorists and the community.

As initially communicated, planned maintenance activities will include localized asphalt repairs, mill-and-pave resurfacing in designated sections, catch basin cleaning, bridge maintenance, graffiti removal, ditching, vegetation control, pavement marking, and signage repairs.

To facilitate the scope of work and uphold health and safety standards, both eastbound and westbound lanes of the Lincoln M. Alexander Parkway will be fully closed from Friday, May 30, 2025, through to Monday, June 2, 2025.

- Eastbound closure: Friday, May 30, 2025 at 8:00 a.m. Monday, June 2, 2025 at 5:00 a.m. from Golf Links Road to the Red Hill Valley Parkway, including the RHVP off ramp from the eastbound LINC; and,
- Westbound closure: Friday, May 30, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. Monday, June 2, 2025 at 5:00 a.m. from the Red Hill Valley Parkway to Highway 403.

Detour routes will be well signed and communications via the City's website, social media, and digital ads will inform residents of the date change, as well as weekend traffic disruptions. Detour routes will be via Mohawk Road and Stone Church Road.
