This Communication Update is to inform the Mayor and Members of Council that the annual general maintenance and asphalt repairs on the Lincoln M. Alexander Parkway scheduled has been rescheduled to June 13-16, 2025, weather pending.

The revised date was coordinated with the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario's (MTO) ongoing maintenance work on the Queen Elizabeth Way (QEW) Niagara-bound at the Burlington Skyway, which will occur over many weekends. Adjusting the timing of the Lincoln M. Alexander repairs ensures the two major routes are not affected at the same time. This approach is intended to help reduce traffic disruptions and minimize the impact on motorists and the community.

As initially communicated, planned maintenance activities will include localized asphalt repairs, mill-and-pave resurfacing in designated sections, catch basin cleaning, bridge maintenance, graffiti removal, ditching, vegetation control, pavement marking, and signage repairs.

To facilitate the scope of work and uphold health and safety standards, both eastbound and westbound lanes of the Lincoln M. Alexander Parkway will be fully closed from Friday, June 13, 2025, through to Monday, June 16, 2025. If the work does not proceed due to weather, a future date will be communicated. The maintenance was initially scheduled for May 23 – 26, 2025 and was postponed due to forecasted weather conditions.

- Eastbound closure: Friday, June13, 2025 at 8:00 a.m. Monday, June 16, 2025 at 5:00 a.m. from Golf Links Road to the Red Hill Valley Parkway, including the RHVP off ramp from the eastbound LINC; and,
- Westbound closure: Friday, June 13, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. Monday, June 16, 2025 at 5:00 a.m. from the Red Hill Valley Parkway to Highway 403.

Detours will be in place via Mohawk Road and Stone Church Road. Motorists can access the 403 eastbound from the Mohawk Road on-ramps. Motorists travelling into Hamilton via the 403 will be directed to exit at the Golf Links off-ramp.

Detour routes will be well signed and communications via the City's website, social media, and digital ads will inform residents of the date change, as well as weekend traffic disruptions.
