What's Happening?

Over the next 3 years, the City of Hamilton is investing to create about **1,200 new affordable and supportive housing units** — helping people across the city access safe, stable homes.



21 total projects
692 affordable units
511 supportive units

How We're Investing: 2024–2026 Housing Commitment:



\$4M / year for Affordable Housing

\$10.3M / year for Supportive Housing

So far, we've already funded:

2024: \$8.2M investment

and **435 supportive** units

What's coming next?

2025: \$17.8M investment
