To Subscribers:

Re: Monthly Report for the month of May 2025

In May the Building Division issued 573 building permits valued at \$183.48 million.

For the month, the residential component was the strongest accounting for 72.39% of the month's total and is valued at \$132.81 million. Of the 397 permits in the residential category, 156 permits were issued for new single-family dwellings at a total value of \$66.84 million. Commercial activity accounts for 15.60% or \$28.61 million with 45 permits issued. Industrial activity accounts for 7.61% or \$13.96 million and the government and institutional activity accounts for 3.35% or \$6.14 million.

We trust these comments will aid you in the understanding of this report.
