As communicated on April 15^{th,} 2025, Ancaster Municipal Service Centre, otherwise known as "Ancaster Square", located at 300 Wilson Street East is currently undergoing roof and HVAC replacement. Due to this necessary work, a planned closure was put into effect from May 5th through June 2nd, 2025.

The critical disruption to HVAC service has been resolved on schedule, allowing reopening to all occupant groups - staff and public, as planned on June 2nd. The remaining roofing and flashing work will continue beyond this date, with demobilization planned for mid to late June.

The displaced occupant groups: Ancaster Municipal Centre and Hamilton Public Library have re-opened today.
