

## INTRODUCTION

### Project Scope

- Proposed Reconstruction & Urbanization of Nebo Road from Rymal Road East to Twenty Road East (Approximate 1.5km). Final design will Include:
  - 2-lane urbanized standard road with a 1.5-2m (varies) sidewalk on Westside of Nebo Road
  - 3m Paved Multi-use trail along the East side of the street between Rymal Road and Twenty Road
  - 1m Green strip between the trail and the curb
  - Concrete Pads (with 2 hammer hoops) for bike parking at the Southeast corner of Rymal Road & Nebo Road and Twenty Road & Nebo Road
  - Sanitary sewer and Storm sewer extensions
  - Watermain replacement
  - Installation of street lighting, traffic signals, pavement markings for lanes, crossings and bike paths, and signage for traffic control

### Project Goal

- To achieve Complete Street and Vision Zero principles as per City of Hamilton Standards
- · Enhancing pedestrian and active transportation safety, mobility and connectivity





## **SCHEDULE**

#### **Revised Project Status and Schedule**

- Design is currently being finalized for tendering
- Anticipated Construction Tendering: Summer/Fall 2025
- Anticipated Construction Commencement: Winter 2026
- Anticipated Construction Completion: Spring 2027





# PROPOSED WORK (SURFACE)

#### Section 1 (Approx. 300m)

- Reconstruction of existing roadway and urbanize to a 2-lane industrial standard road
- Existing watermain to be replaced
- Concrete pad to be installed at Southeast corner of Twenty Road & Nebo Road meeting Accessibility for Ontarians with Disability Act (AODA) standards
- 3m Multi Use Path (MUP) to be installed along the East side of the street

#### Section 3 (Approx. 360m)



- Reconstruction of existing roadway and urbanization to a
  2-lane industrial arterial road
- Concrete pad to be installed at southeast corner of Rymal & Nebo meeting AODA standards
- 3m MUP to be installed along the east side of the street
- Proposed landscape planting on both sides along Road



# PROPOSED WORK

#### **Underground Work (Section A)**

- Watermain Replacement = Approx 240m (Section A)
  - 200 mm dia. Watermain
- Proposed Storm Sewer = Approx 90m (Section A)
  - 900 mm dia. Storm Sewer

# PROPOSED WORK

#### **Underground Work (Section B)**



- Watermain Replacement = Approx 310m (Section B)
  - 200 mm dia. Watermain
- Proposed Storm Sewer = Approx 320m (Section B)
  - 900 mm dia. Storm Sewer
- Proposed Sanitary Sewer = Approx 325m (Section B)
  - 375 mm dia. Sanitary Sewer




# PROPOSED WORK

#### **Underground Work (Section C)**

- Proposed Storm Sewer = Approx 280m (Section C)
- Proposed Storm Sewer = Approx 45m (Trenchless zone)
- Proposed Sanitary Sewer = Approx 258m (Section C)



# TRAFFIC IMPACT & DETOUR PLAN

#### Rymal Road East to Twenty Road East



- During construction and closure of any parts of Nebo Road, public traffic can use east parallel road Dartnall Road as detour. A detour signage in accordance with Ontario Traffic Manual need to be set up and implemented to accommodate traffic
- Local access for businesses will be maintained at all times using compacted gravel surfaces
- Rebuild the road in stages to limit disruption and keep traffic flowing where possible


