The purpose of this Communication Update is to provide information about planned events and programming from the Sustainable Mobility section for September 2025, including Smart Commute Month, and Open Streets.

## Background

- 1) Smart Commute Month is a campaign of the Ontario-wide Smart Commute program in various municipalities and regions including: City of Hamilton, City of London, City of Toronto, Durham Region, Greater Region of Sudbury, Oakville, Halton Hills, York Region, and Bruce County. The focus of the campaign is to collect travel data on how staff at partner workplaces are getting to and from work and to engage with commuters to explore sustainable travel options available to them.
- 2) At Council's direction, the City's first **Open Streets** Temporary Linear Urban Park on King Street East was held in June 2023. The program continued in 2024 and 2025, with the bi-annual closure of King Street East to motor vehicle traffic from John Street to Gage Avenue, approximately four kilometres in length. Open Streets continues with the next event taking place on Sunday, September 28, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

#### Open Streets on King - Sunday, September 28, 2025

- o Time: 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Location: King Street East, from John Street to Gage Avenue
- Open Streets invites residents to experience a temporary car-free King Street, showcasing how our public spaces can be reimagined for active transportation and community connection. The event includes family-friendly programming, cycling activities, local organizations, and more.

Both programs support several key objectives in Hamilton's transportation and climate strategies, including:

- Advancing mode shift and supporting the goals of the City's Cycling Master Plan
- Promoting Vision Zero and safer streets for all road users
- Encouraging sustainable mobility and reduced Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions
- Fostering community engagement and public health benefits

#### **Participation and Promotion**

Councillors and the Mayor are encouraged to stop by the Smart Commute table at City Hall on September 17, as well as attend and promote Open Streets on September 28, within their Wards and networks. These events are opportunities to engage with residents and demonstrate the City's commitment to active transportation and sustainable urban mobility.
