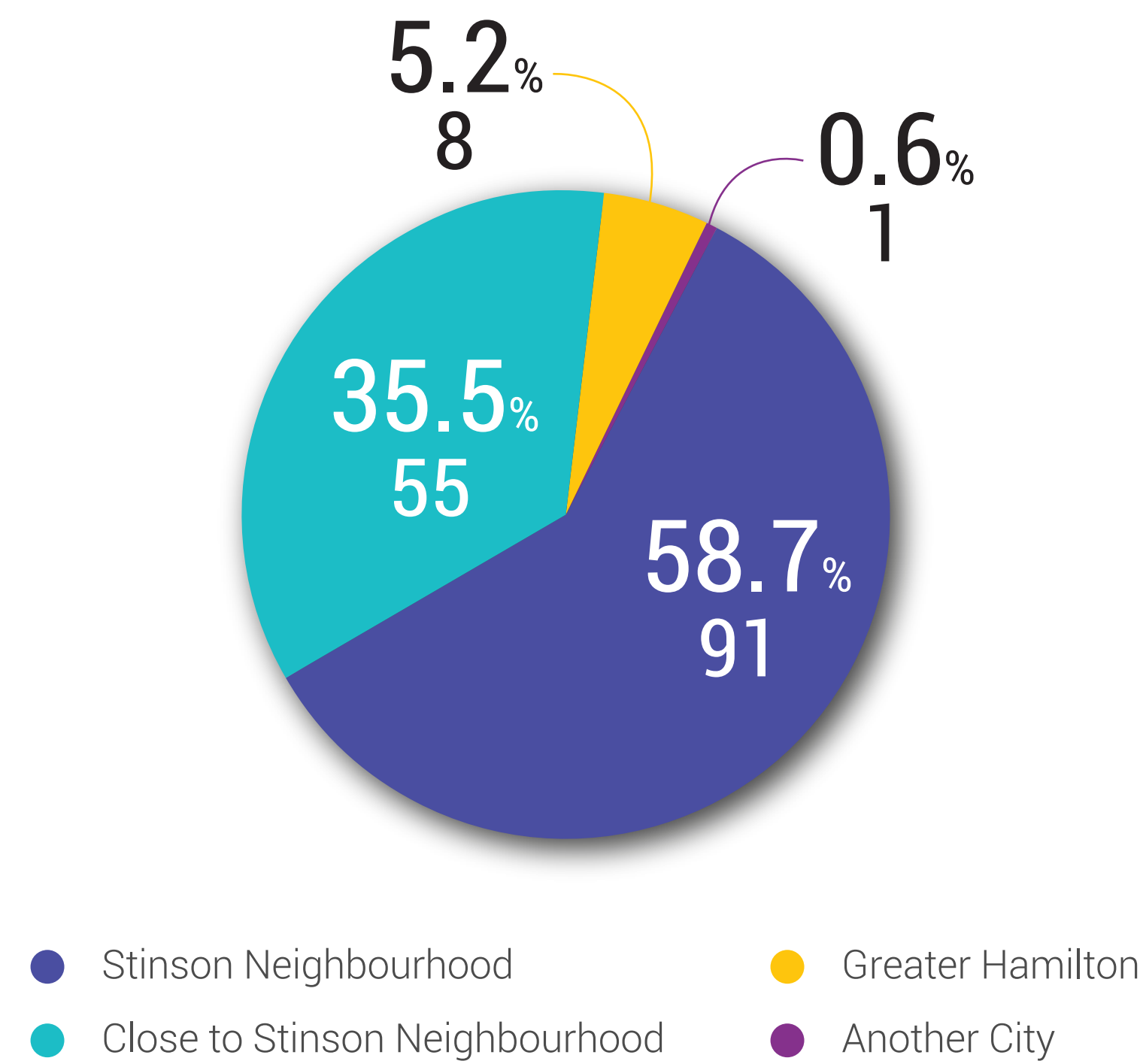

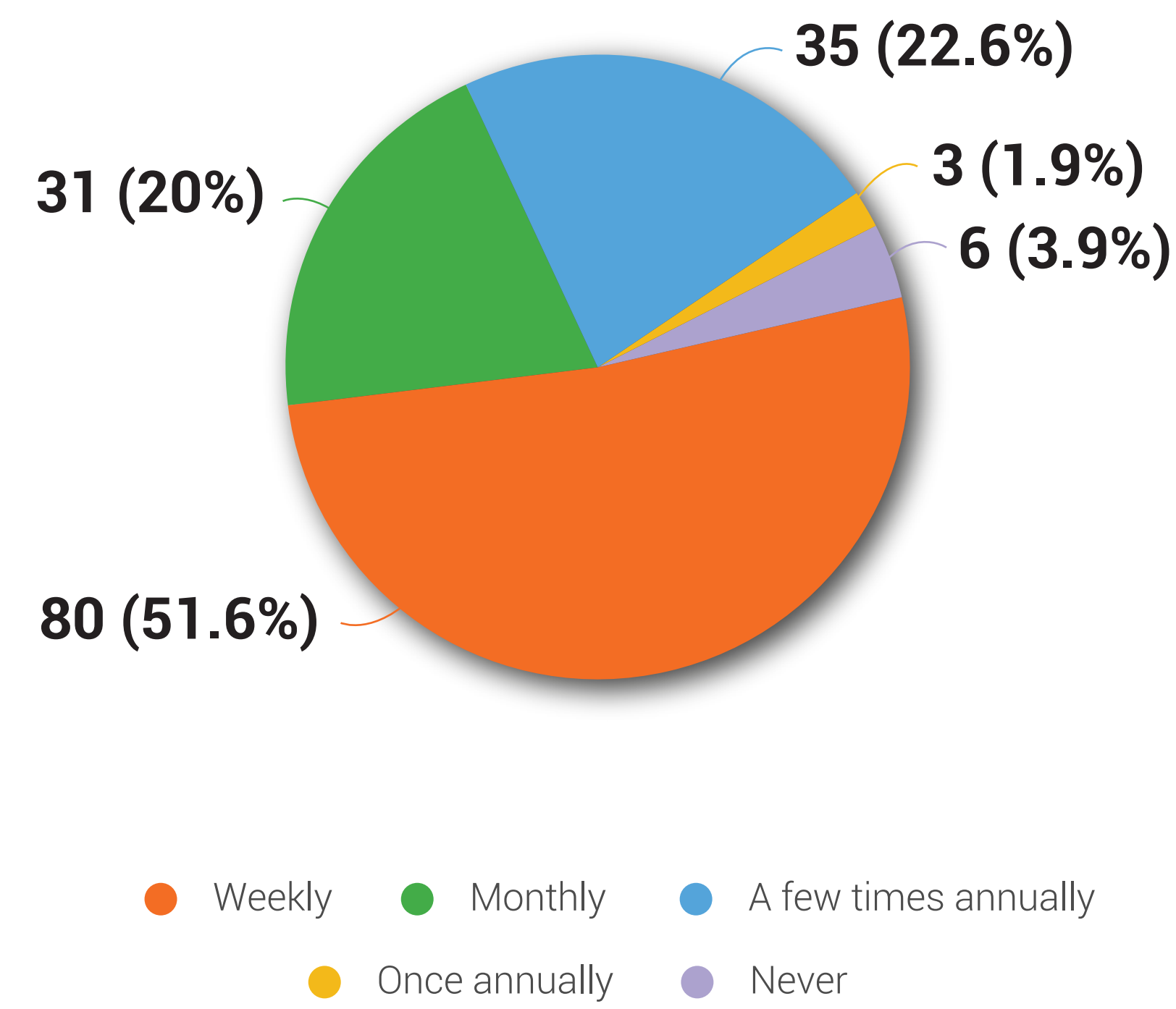

Where do you live?



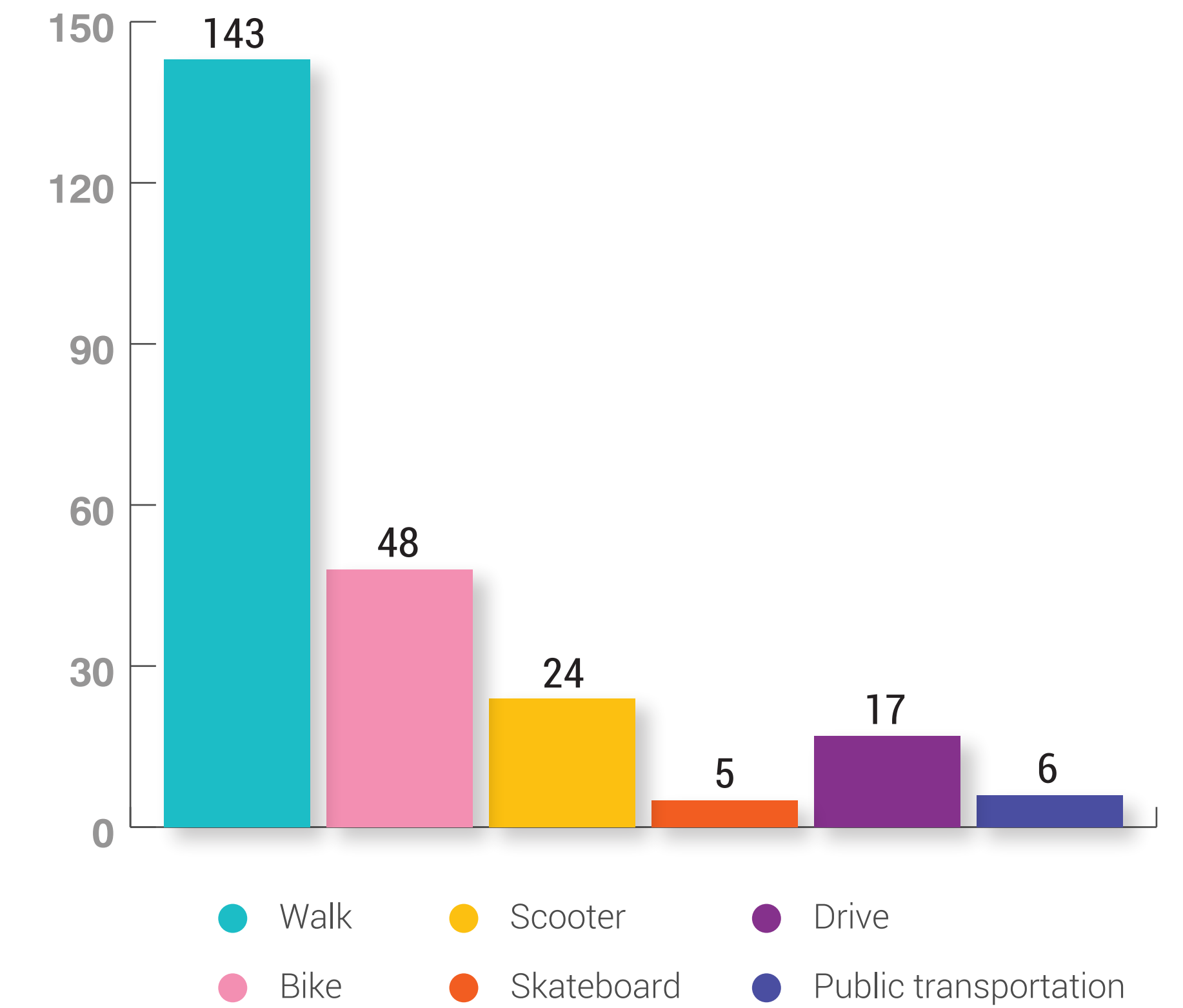

How often do you use the amenities at the park?



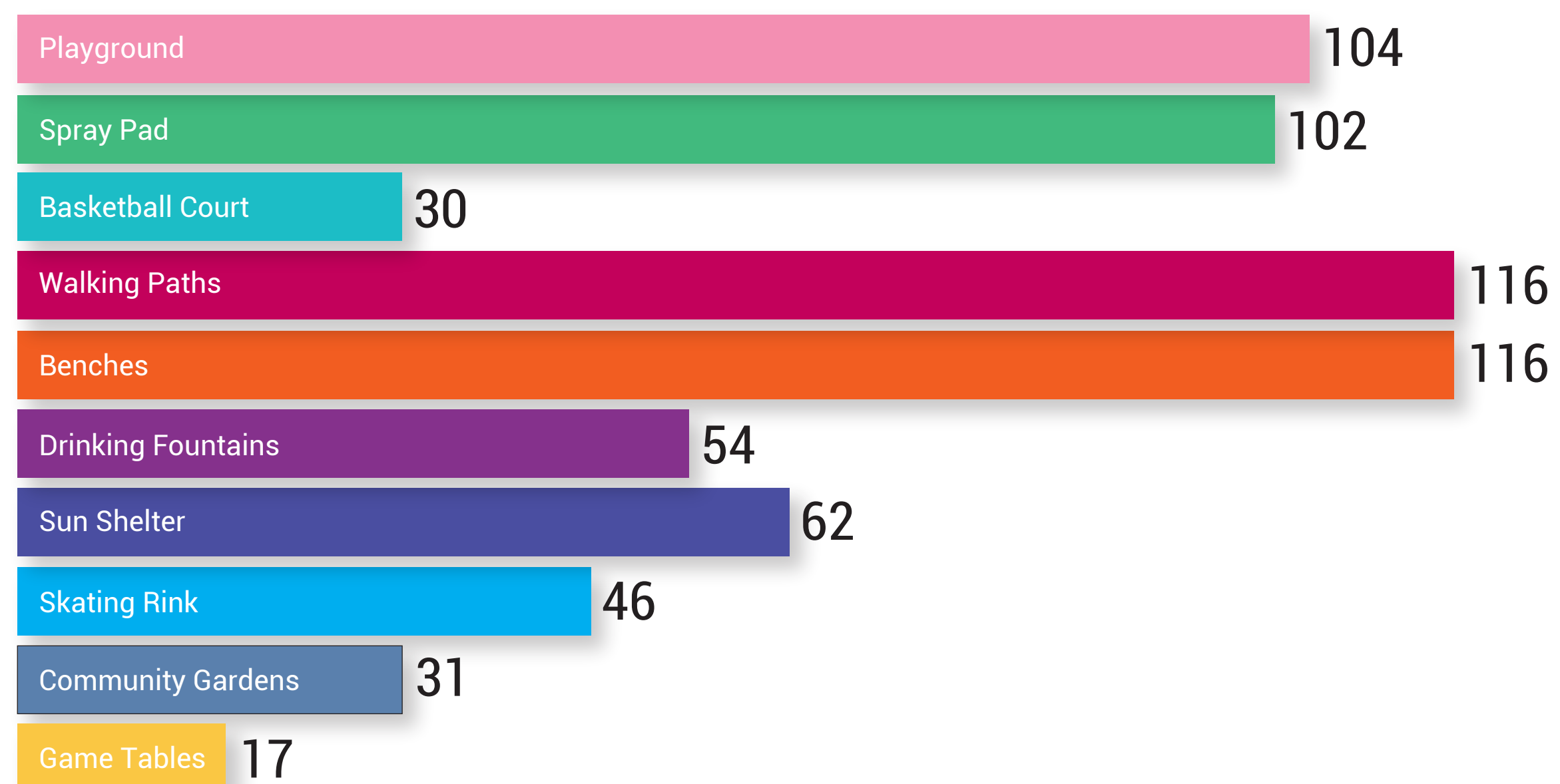

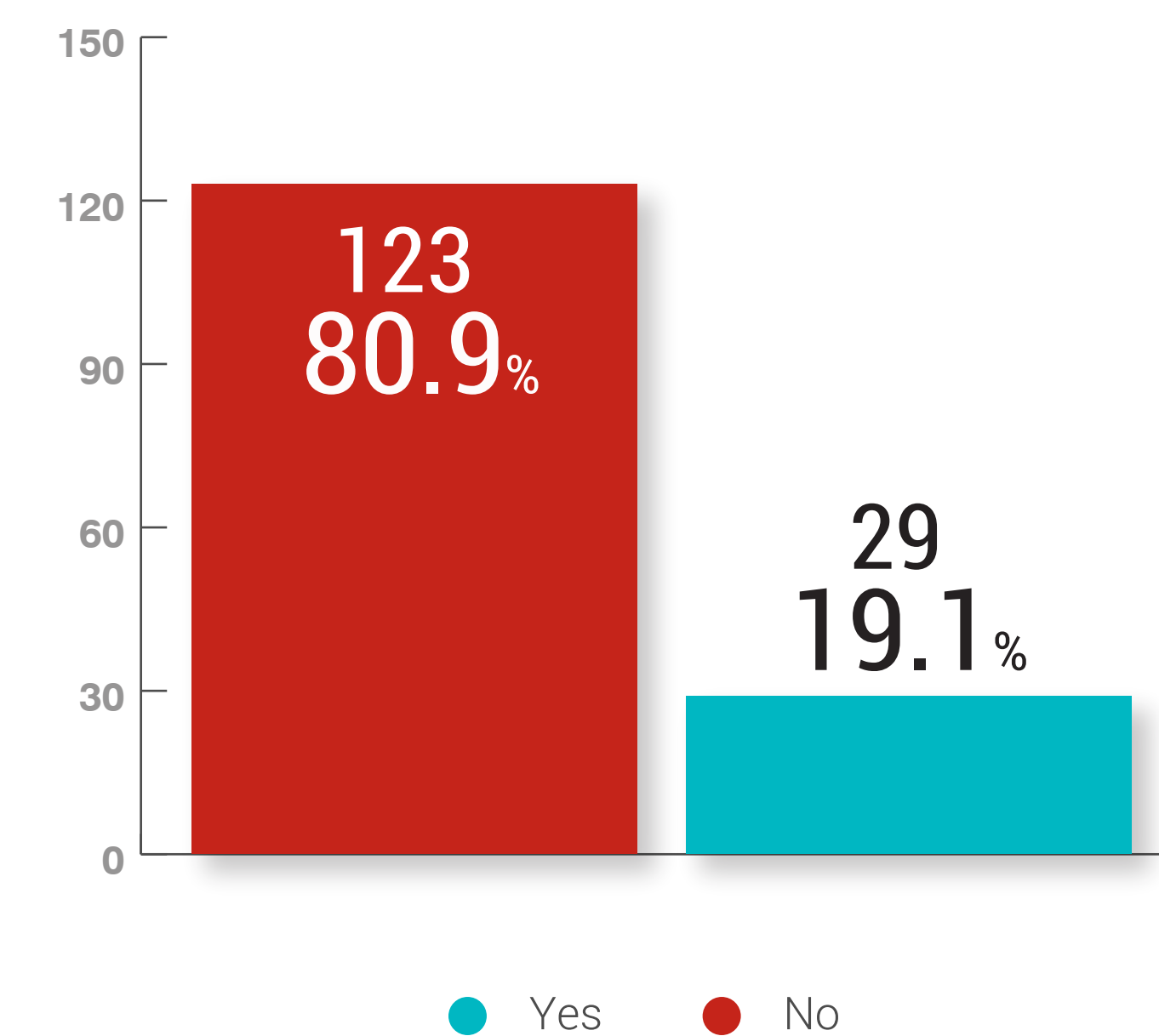

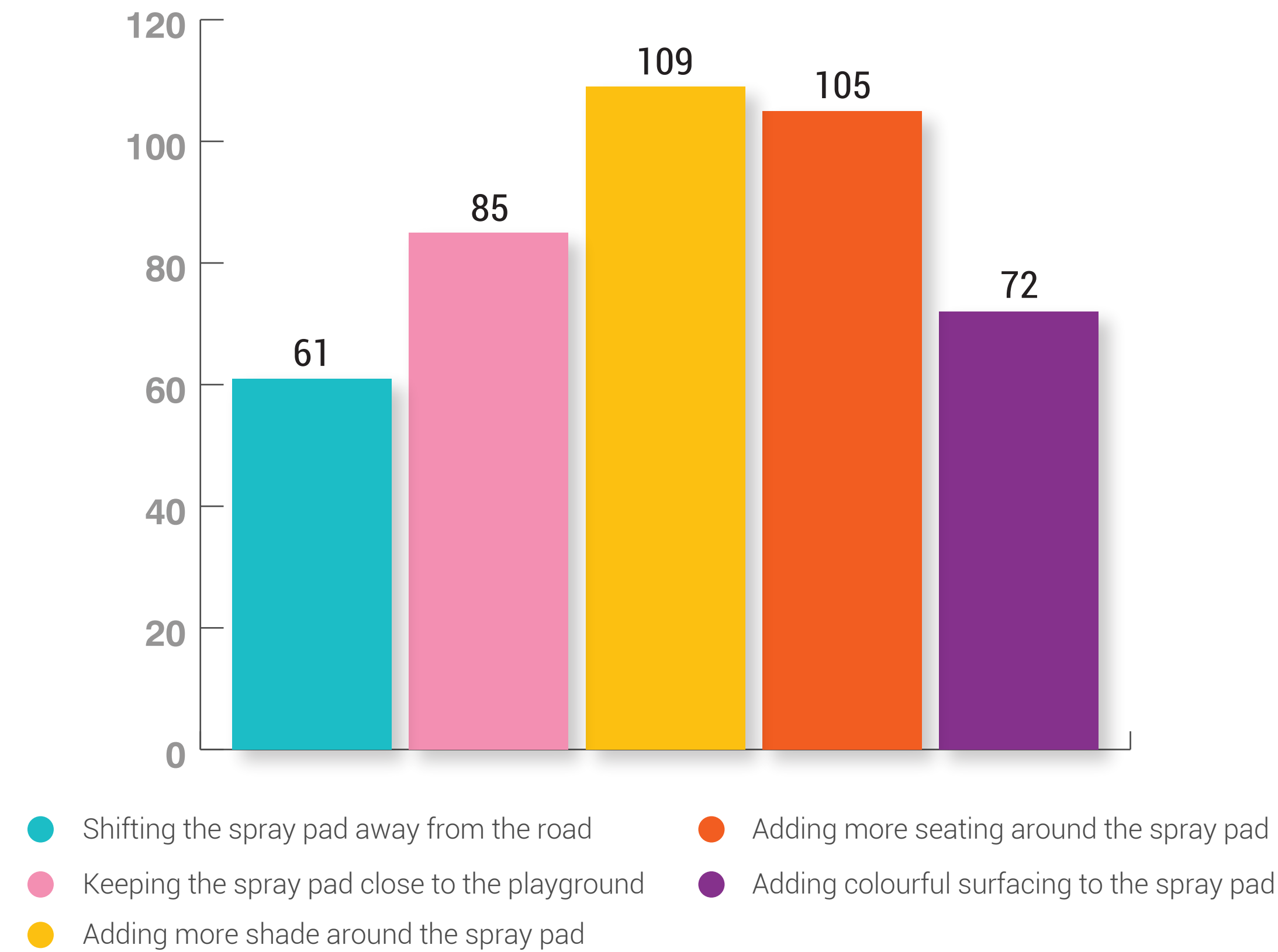

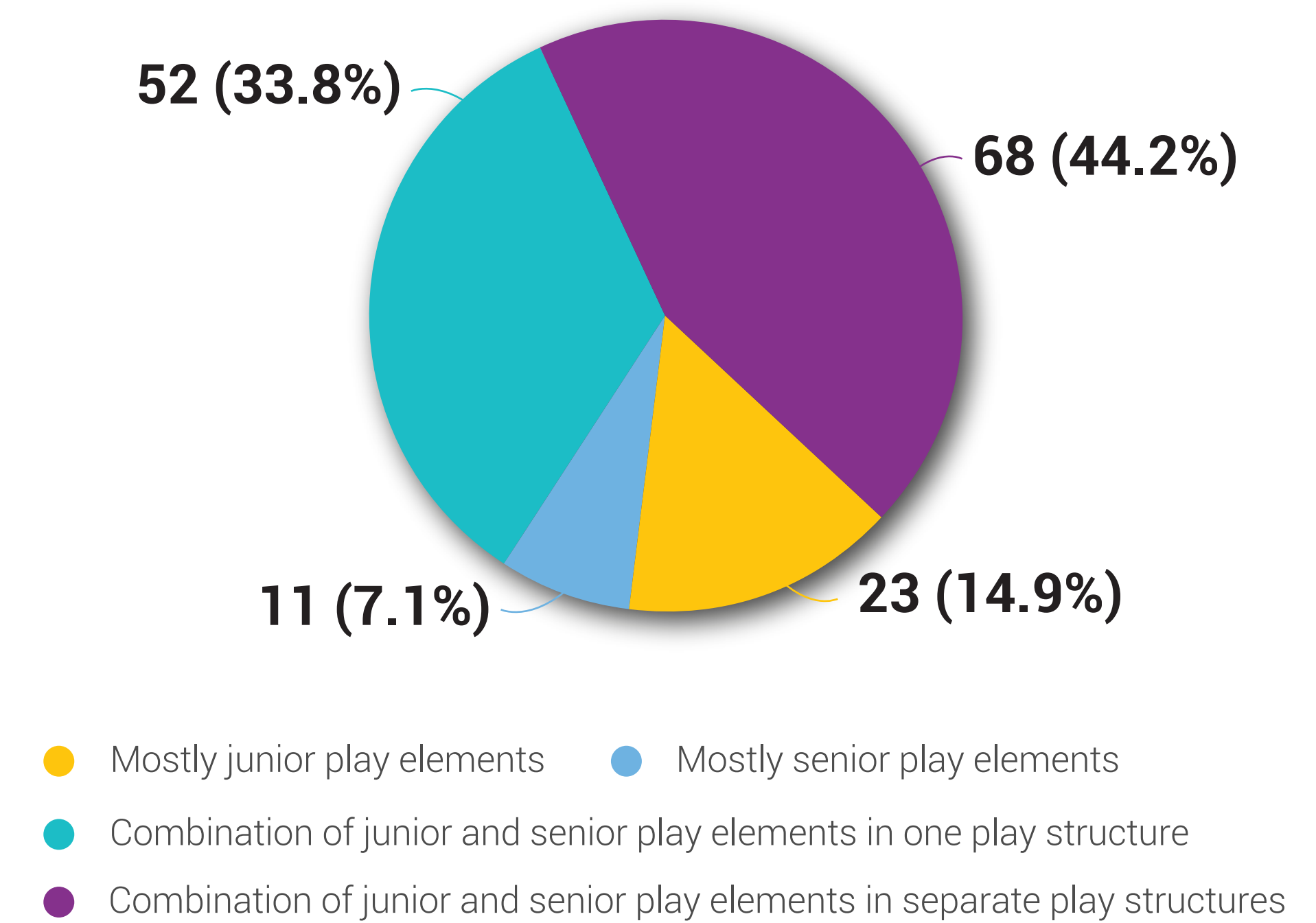

For the spray pad redesign, which of the following considerations are important to you?



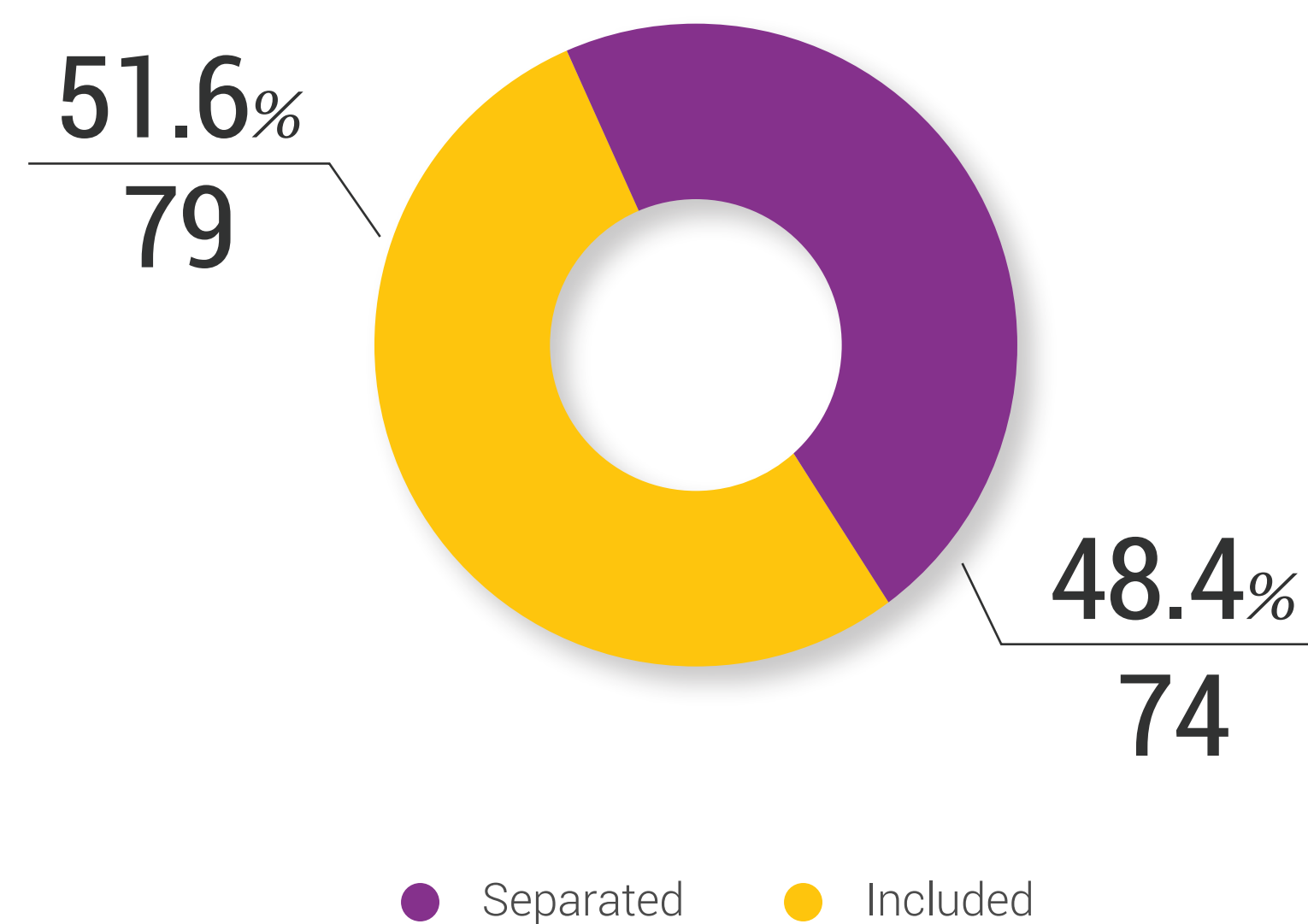

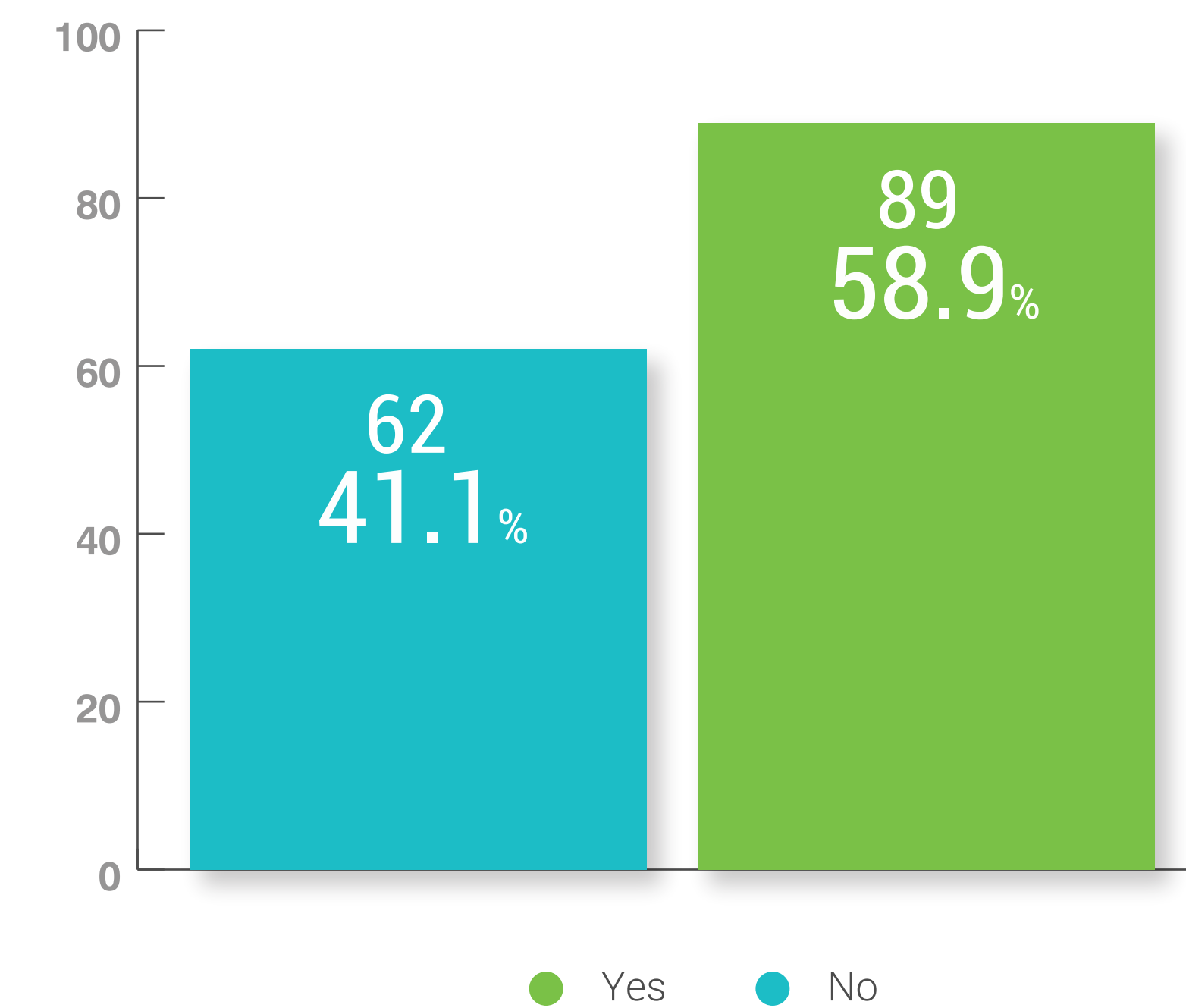
