Re: Monthly Report for the month of July 2025

In July the Building Division issued 439 building permits valued at \$289.81 million.

For the month, the residential component was the strongest accounting for 50.92% of the month's total and is valued at \$147.57 million. Of the 270 permits in the residential category, 85 permits were issued for new single-family dwellings at a total value of \$46.85 million. Commercial activity accounts for 2.94% or \$8.51 million with 42 permits issued. Industrial activity accounts for 29.22% or \$84.67 million and the government and institutional activity accounts for 16.14% or \$46.77 million.

We trust these comments will aid you in the understanding of this report.
