What's Happening?

From 2024-2026, the City of Hamilton will invest in approximately **2,100 new affordable, supportive and attainable housing units** — helping people across the city access safe, stable homes.



30 total projects
1,455 affordable units
511 supportive units
138 attainable units
3 City-owned sites for non-market housing

How We're Investing: 2024–2026 Housing Commitment: **\$59.4M**



So far, we've already funded:

2024: \$8.2M investment

11 Projects in 2025

↑ Adding **440 affordable** units and **435 supportive** units

What's coming next?

2025: \$36.2M investment

17 Projects Supported

↑ Adding **910 affordable** units, **138 attainable** units and **25 supportive** units

2026: \$15M investment

2 New Projects

↑ Adding **105 affordable** units and **51 supportive** units
