

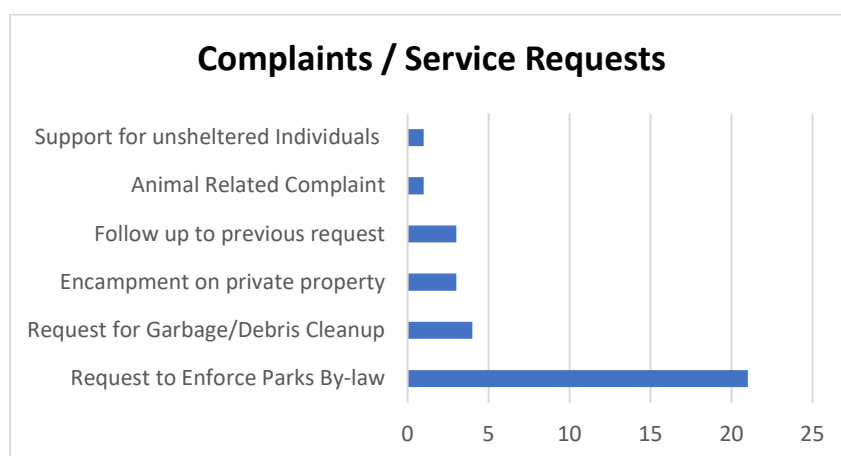

## Complaints/ Service Request Types
