Prices in effect January 1, 2026. **HST is not included.** HST #889323218RT001. Non-Resident rates require an additional 25% assessment on all property sales. Care and Maintenance Fees are included in our prices. Hamilton Municipal Cemeteries are operated by the City of Hamilton.

Care and Maintenance

Care and Maintenance Fees are included in all property purchases. Care and Maintenance Fund: As a requirement under the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002 and Ontario Regulation 30/11, 40% of the purchase price of all adult graves and lots (minimum \$290.00), Child/Infant graves and lots 40% (minimum \$175.00), 40% of Cremation Grave (minimum \$175.00), 20% of the purchase price of all mausoleums (minimum \$830.00), 15% of the purchase price of all columbarium/niches (minimum \$165.00) and Scattering Ground 1 S/R Holder (single) 40% (minimum \$115.00), Scattering Ground S/R Holder (multiple) 15% (minimum \$30.00) and Scattering Grounds No S/R Holder \$30.00 are contributed into an irrevocable trust fund - The Care and Maintenance Fund. Income from the Care and Maintenance Fund is used to provide general care and maintenance of the Cemetery in perpetuity.

Care and Maintenance Fees for monuments and markers are additional and outlined in the Monuments and Markers Section.

Bereavement Authority of Ontario Consumer Protection Fee is \$30.00 per interment. The fee is charged by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO) in order to provide its services of information on your options bereavement services and to regulate the profession making sure the law is consistently followed.

Payment Options

We accept cheque, Visa, and Mastercard. Interac (Debit card) is available at our administrative office only. We do not accept cash payments.

Payment Terms:

For services at time of death: For all at-need cemetery purchases, payment is due in full

Pre-payment in advance of need: For services and supplies that are being arranged pre-need, you may pay for the services and supplies at today's prices and we will place your funds in a trust fund until the pre-paid contract is fulfilled (when supplies and services are delivered)

Finance options are available for pre-need options (12 and 24 months payment options) interest free, with no commission or service charges.

In-ground Interment Rights: A deposit of 40% is due at the time of purchase, with balance payable over 12 or 24 months.

Columbariums, Cremation Niches, Cremation Benches and Family Estate Niches: A deposit of 15% is due at the time of purchase, with balance payable over 12 or 24 months.

Prices are subject to change without notice. Prices listed do not include HST and are in effect as of January 1, 2026. Additional information is available upon request.

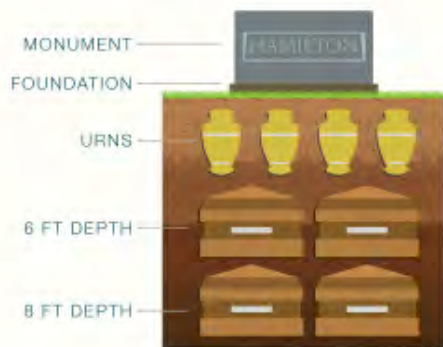

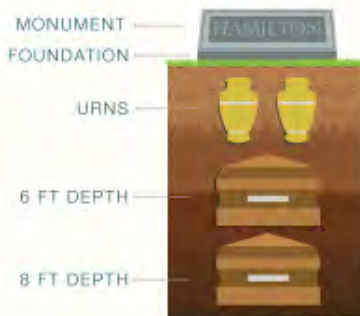

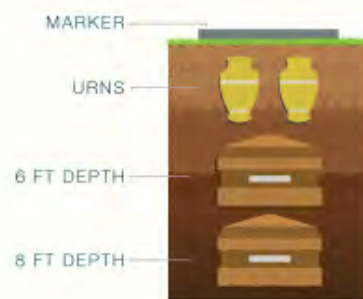

Vaults and Outer Containers – Burials

Outer Burial Containers and Vaults are concrete shells protecting the casket from the weight of the land, moistures and shifting that can occur underground. A burial vault does not preserve your loved one, rather ensures the natural burial process can take place without the influence of the environment. An Outer Burial Container or Vault is required for all Double Depth (8 ft) interments as outlined in our Cemetery By-Laws.

Liners/Vaults: The following price includes the use of grave dressings and lowering device or crypt hangers.

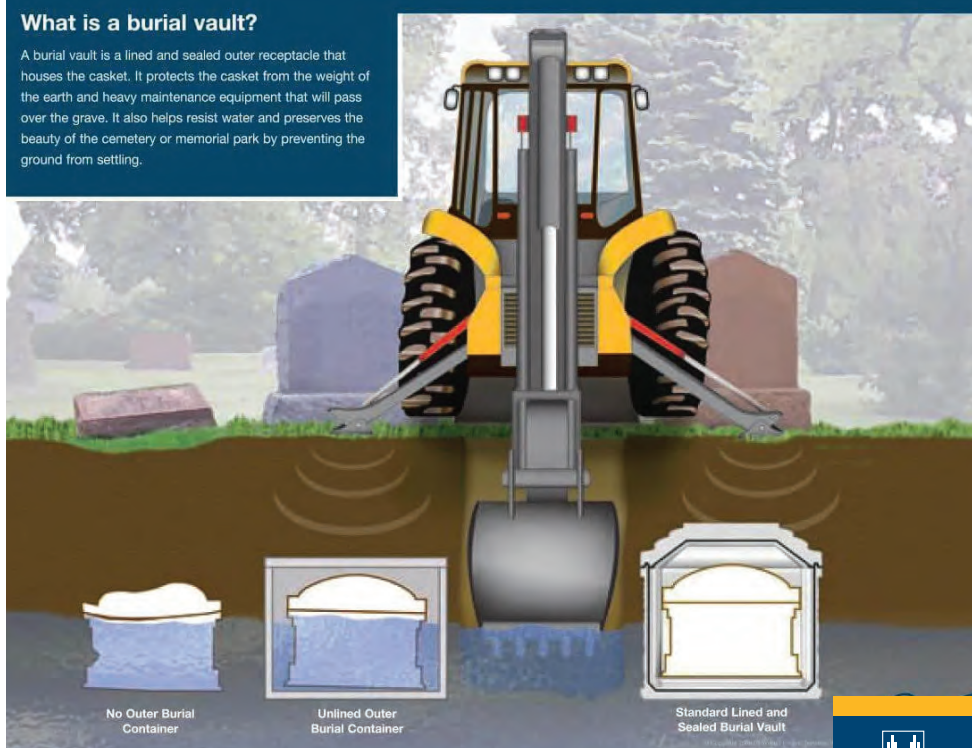

What is a burial vault?

A burial vault is a lined and sealed outer receptacle that houses the casket. It protects the casket from the weight of the earth and heavy maintenance equipment that will pass over the grave. It also helps resist water and preserves the beauty of the cemetery or memorial park by preventing the ground from settling.

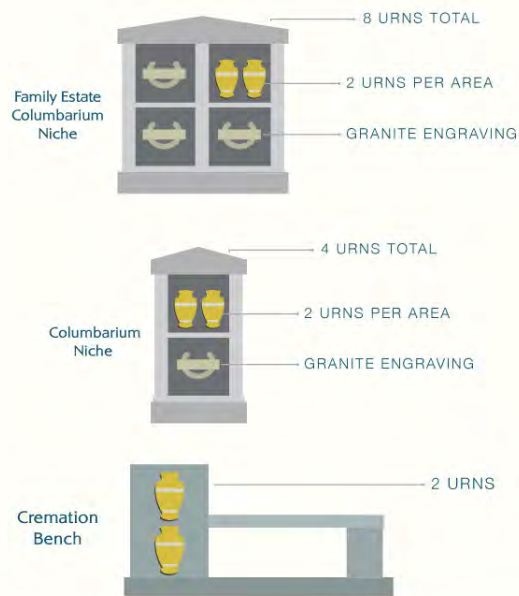

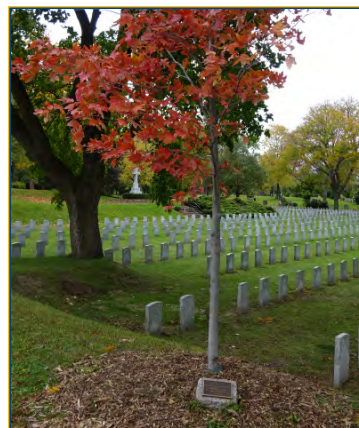

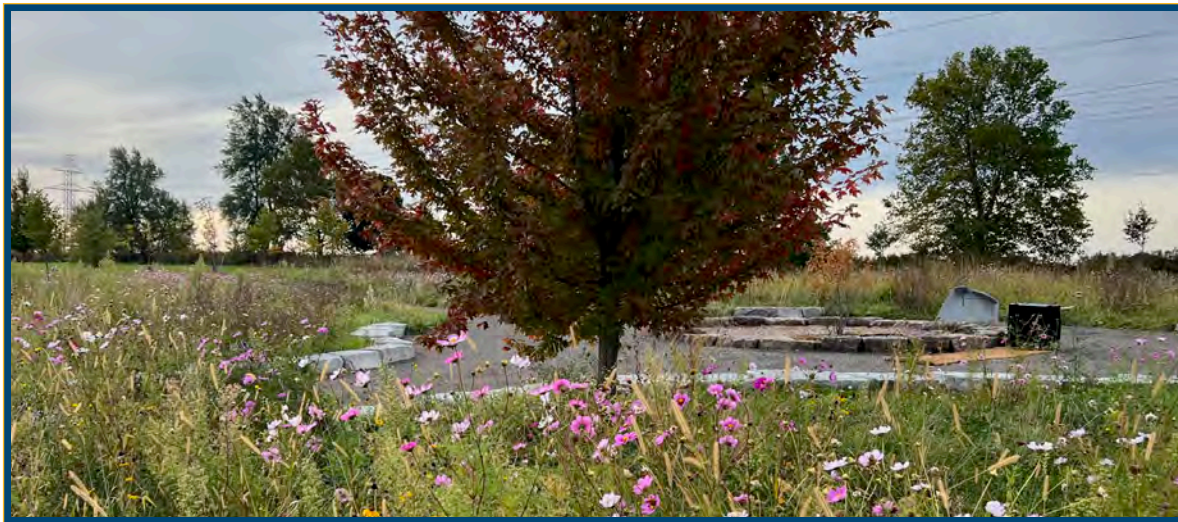
