

BY-LAW No. 9746

To Establish and Lay Out an alley in the block bounded by Hope, Archibald, Britannia and Kenilworth Avenues.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of The City of Hamilton is empowered under Section 459 of The Municipal Act, being Chapter 249 of The Revised Statutes of Ontario 1960, to establish and lay out highways, and

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of The City of Hamilton deems it expedient to establish as an alley, certain lands hereinafter described in this by-law, and

WHEREAS The Corporation of The City of Hamilton is the owner of the lands hereinafter more particularly described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Hamilton enacts as follows:

1. The lands described as

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the City of Hamilton, in the County of Wentworth, and Province of Ontario, and being composed of all of Lot 6, in Block 6, according to Kenilworth Survey, registered in the Registry Office for the Registry Division of the County of Wentworth, as Plan No. 395, and part of Lot 14 according to Kenilworth Addition Survey, registered in the said Registry Office as Plan No. 564, and which said parcel may be more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at a point in the northern limit of Britannia Avenue, at the south-western angle of the said Lot 6.

THENCE northerly along the western limit of the said Lot 6, and the western limit of the said Lot 14, four hundred feet and seven inches (400'-7") more or less to the north-western angle of the said Lot 14, being at a point in the southern limit of Hope Avenue.

THENCE easterly along the said southern limit of Hope Avenue, twenty-five feet and zero inches (25'-0").

THENCE southerly parallel to the western limit of the said Lot 14, to and along the eastern limit of the said Lot 6, four hundred feet and nine inches (400'-9") more or less to the aforesaid northern limit of Britannia Avenue.

THENCE westerly along the northern limit of Britannia Avenue, twenty-five feet and zero inches (25'-0") more or less to the place of beginning, as shown outlined in red on City Engineer's Plan No. N.S. 931 Surveys appended hereto as Schedule "A" are hereby established as a public highway.

2. The City Engineer or his duly authorized agent is hereby authorized to open up the public highway referred to in Section 1 so as to include the lands described in Section 1.

3. This By-law comes into force on the day on which it is enacted by the Council of The Corporation of the City of Hamilton.
