## **SUBJECT: 2026 Call for Applications for Social Housing Capital Repairs**

City of Hamilton, Housing Services Division is currently accepting applications for capital and vacant unit repair funding through the 2026 Call for Applications for Social Housing Capital Repairs.

Application must be submitted:

- No later than **July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026 11:59pm local time**
- On the application form provided

- With the Subject Line: “2026 Capital Funding Application – Provider Name, Address of Proposed Repair”

One application is to be submitted per address with proposed repairs. Up to five (5) capital repair projects, and four (4) vacant unit repairs may be submitted per application (on four separate forms one for each unit).

Eligibility to access capital repair funding (loan or grant) under these programs is limited to social housing providers that are administered within a transferred housing program under the HSA for the City of Hamilton. For the purposes of these programs social housing is defined as follows:

“Social Housing” means those housing projects that are, as of April 1, 2019, administered within a “transferred housing program” as described in Schedule 1 to O.Reg.367/11 under the Housing Services Act, 2011, S.O. 2011, c.6, Sched.1, and remain within a transferred housing program at the time of commitment and use of the Funds for the housing project and include urban native social housing units administered under either Program No.7: Non-Profit & Urban Native “Fully Targeted” Housing Program or Program No.8: Urban Native “2% Write-Down & Additional Assistance” Program of Schedule C to the CMHC-Ontario Social Housing Agreement dated November 15, 1999; but ‘Social Housing’ excludes housing that was or is only within either of Program No. 2: “Rent Supplement Program” or Program No. 9: “Rural and Native Homeownership Program” or Schedule C to the CMHC-Ontario Social Housing Agreement dated November 15, 1999.”
