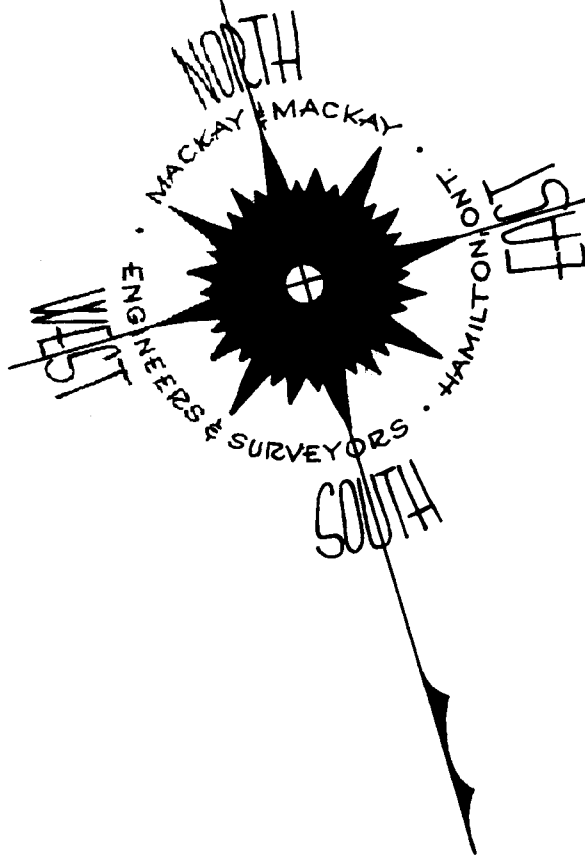


Survey
